



Annisquam River Dredging & Offshore Disposal

IPSWICH BAY, MASSACHUSETTS

Cashman was contracted to conduct dredging and offshore disposal at Ipswich Bay for the removal of ~1,000 cubic yards of shoaled material on behalf of the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- The project involved dredging shoaled material from the north entrance of the Annisquam River.
- Material was placed at an off-shore disposal area in Ipswich Bay, near Gloucester.
- Approximately 1,000 cubic yards of material were dredged and transported.
- The Cashman team used the *Wood 1* dredge equipped with a “clamshell” style bucket.
